The Horses for Handicapped of Pinellas program is a private, non-profit organization for the purpose of promoting and teaching recreational horseback riding and care to the special needs citizens of our community.

Horseback riding is widely recognized as one of the most beneficial forms of recreational therapy disabled persons can receive. It develops self awareness, builds self-confidence, improves concentration and discipline. Horseback riding also improves posture, balance, and coordination as well as increasing joint mobility and core stabilization.

In 1981, our program was founded by the late Gene Harris as a Kiwanis service project in partnership with Mary Urquhart's 4-H/Girl Scout club. To this day, we operate 100% on volunteer staff and donations from the community. We serve over 75 riders and horse lovers each week.
